Media school

It is a place of learning where various media are used to discover oneself to develop an eye of looking at society and exploring careers spontaneously, with 'Let's find a new-self inside media' as the motto.

Guidelines for applicants

- A two-year diploma course (4 terms)
- December to February every year, July ~ August recruiting new students
- Subjects : out-of-school youth of 15 ~ 19 years old
- Phone and visiting meeting > Accepting application > Preliminary term

Learning through projects

- Individual project : a project that one can display their abilities only with their will to learn
- Media project : a project where we all together agonize how to express, with media as the base
- Travel project : a project that strengthens the team spirit by experiencing firsthand in an unfamiliar place
- Art project (Musical, drama, B-boy, rap etc.)

Learning the basics

- Basic media education (Photoshop, premier program etc. editing programs / photo, video filming / storytelling etc. scenario writing)
- Reading, humanities, oomph (staff mentoring), autonomous conference
- Media literacy education, storytelling, video production, writing

Counselling related

Career, overall psychological test, individual counselling support, misocenter

Career related

SSRO-intern (media career internship, orientation etc), Miraeya

Term system course

Admission	admission counselling, accepting application, orientation (school introduction, psychological test, health examination)
Preliminary term	small projects, planning individual projects, group recreation, starting trip
Regular term	project learning, basic education course, mentoring etc.
Completing the course	learning outcome presentation, graduation ceremony (essay, portfolio, result report, self-evaluation report)
Graduation process (4 terms completed)	graduation application and consent form, autobiography, portfolio, graduation

Youth media treatment counselling and prevention

Develop various counselling strategies using media like movies, picture books, photos etc., and supports cyber verbal bullying prevention, media addiction phased counselling and treatment

Media treatment individual counselling

Individual counselling (teenagers, parents) and psychological test

- Teenagers and parents who have psychological · emotional trouble or have trouble using media
- Utilizing media mediums (photo, movie, picture book, picture card, art etc.)
- Time : During the year (Monday ~ Friday 10~18 o' clock)
- Subject · cost : intake interview (15,000 won), youth (5,000 won), parents (10,000 won), psychological test (telephone enquiry)

Media treatment group counselling

Group counselling using media treatment methods (90 minutes / once)

- Time : during the year
- Subject · cost : youth (80,000 won), teachers · parents (100,000 won)

'Three questions' for a warm hearted cyber world

Cyber verbal bullying preventing education and activity (2 times, 2 hours)

- Time: operating April ~ December
- Subject · cost : Grades 3 ~ 6 (Education by class), Free (first-come-first-served basis)

Our media communication

Media addiction preventing education and board game

- Time : during the year
- Subject · cost : youth (70,000 won), teachers · parents (100,000 won)

Smartphone addiction preventing parent education

Education on how to communicate and provide usage guidance to children using smartphones

- (Seoul Metropolitan Office of Education parent Cyber ethics education related)
- Time : during the year
- Subject · cost : more than 40 parents, free

Youth internet · smartphone addiction prevention solution business

Grades 4, 7, and 10, youth internet · smartphone using habits

- investigation and healing service
- Time : during the year (operated through associating with schools)
- Subject · cost : free, youth of 8 ~ 19 years old
